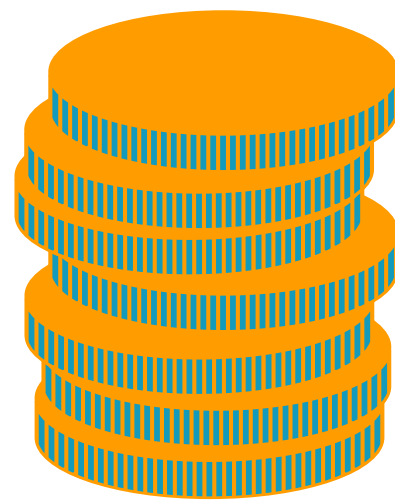

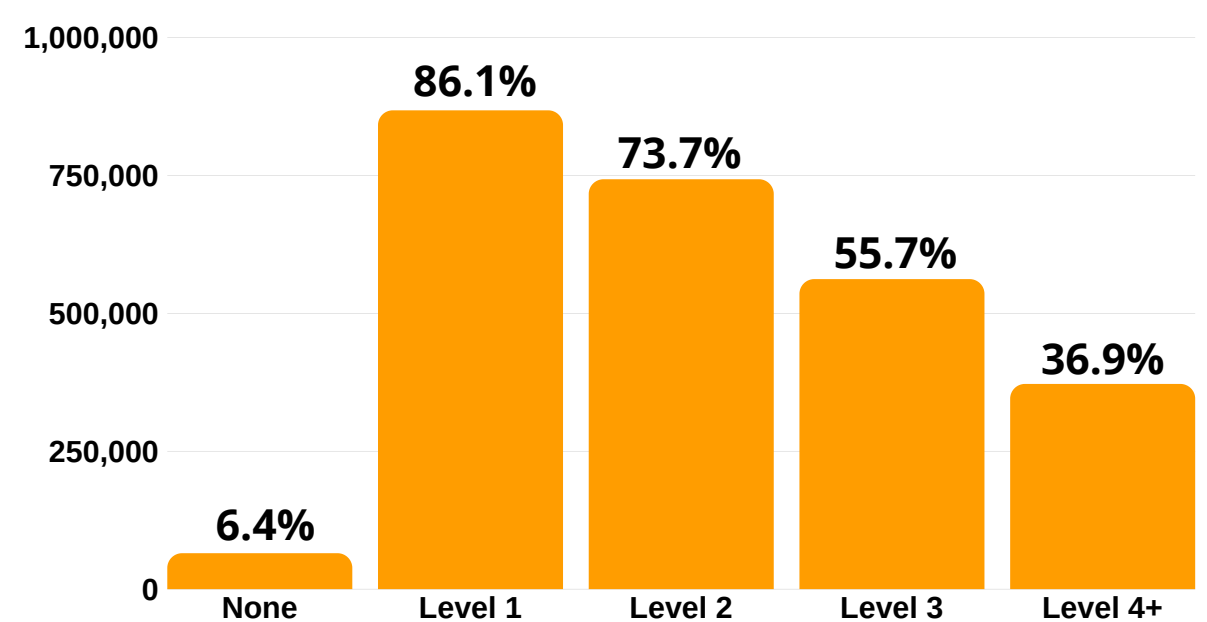
Growth by job sector by 2022
